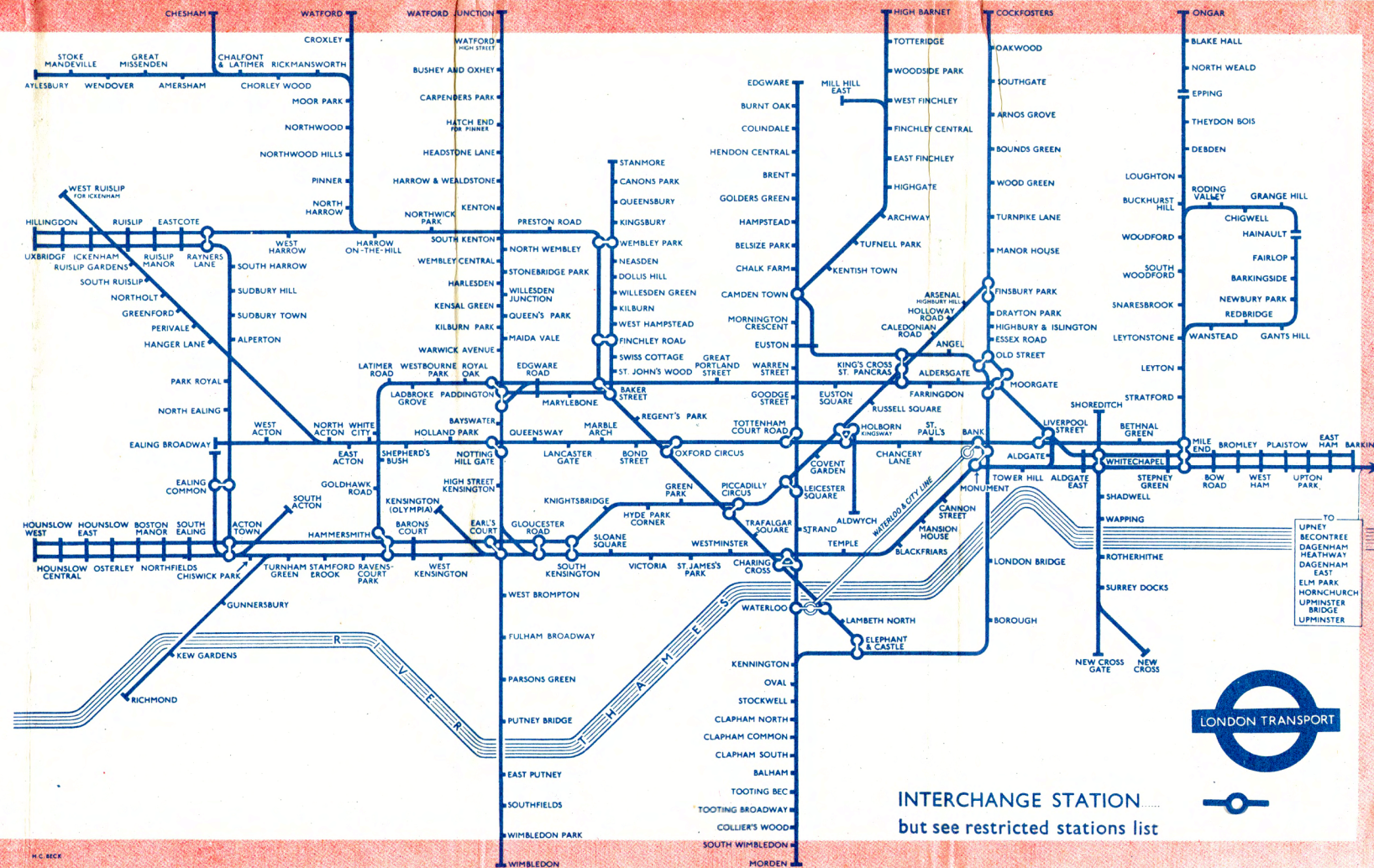


THIS FOLDER

- 1** A detailed Large Map showing the Processional Route, the Coronation Area closed to general vehicular traffic and the Ring Road surrounding it, and the colours which will guide you to The Route.
 - 2** A Small Map of all London Transport Railways showing interchange stations.
 - 3** Full details of how to reach The Route whether you go by public transport services or by private car or taxi.
- Please study the Large Map carefully beforehand, decide where you wish to go, and note the colour of that section of The Route. Then follow the detailed instructions on the Large Map and inside this folder relevant to that colour.

The Police and the Transport authorities are anxious to help the public in every way they can—they ask for public co-operation in making the arrangements work smoothly.

Neither the Police nor the Transport authorities can be held responsible for any mistakes in this folder or for any consequences of possible alterations to the programme after this folder has gone to press. No spectator can be guaranteed access to The Route but every endeavour will be made to be helpful and fair to all.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Make up your mind beforehand from which section of The Route you wish to see the Procession. Note the colour of this section as shown on the Large Map. This will enable you to get the right train, bus, trolleybus or Green Line coach, or to apply for the right windscreen label if you are going by private car.

The Coronation Area, but not the Ring Road surrounding it (see Large Map), will be closed to general vehicular traffic throughout Coronation Day. But London Transport buses and coaches will enter the Coronation Area and set down at Coronation Terminals within easy walking distance of The Route. The Police, therefore, advise you to use public transport. Travel either by rail to the station remaining open nearest the section of The Route you wish to reach, or go by bus or Green Line coach to the nearest Coronation Terminal for your section; or go by bus trolleybus or Green Line coach as near as possible to the Coronation Area. (See Large Map—route numbers in blue).

WALKING TO YOUR PLACE You will have to go on foot to your position from stations, from Coronation Terminals, or from setting down points for cars. If you wish to enter or cross The Route there are fixed Entry Points at which you may do so. These are marked on the Large Map. The Entry Points will be kept open as long as possible. You are advised to approach The Route by the side street nearest to your final position.

RESERVED PLACES The following places are reserved for children, ex-servicemen and other organisations **only** :—Queen's Gdns. (Victoria Memorial); Victoria Embankment; Bridge St. (south side); the south, east and west sides of Parliament Sq.; Wellington Statue Island, Hyde Park Cnr. **SEAT HOLDERS** If you have a reserved position you are advised to be there early, but, however early you are, access is not guaranteed. Stands or premises for viewing are best entered from behind. This will be easier if you find out the exact position of your entrance in advance.

If your seat cannot be reached without entering or crossing The Route, you are advised to arrive not later than the following times :—

For Queen's Gdns., The Mall, Cockspur St., Trafalgar Sq., Northumberland Ave., Victoria Embankment, Bridge St., Parliament Sq., Broad Sanctuary, Parliament St. and Whitehall—6 a.m. For Haymarket, Pall Mall, St. James's St., Piccadilly, Hyde Park Cnr., East Carriage Rd. (Hyde Park), —7 a.m. For Marble Arch, Oxford St., Oxford Circus, Regent St. and Piccadilly Circus—9 a.m.

YOU WILL BE HUNGRY It would be wise to bring refreshments with you.

GETTING HOME After the Procession, please remain in position until the troops have left, and then make your way to the nearest London Transport station or the nearest Coronation Terminal for bus or Green Line coach.

TRADESMEN Deliveries of goods or food to premises on The Route must be completed by midnight on 1st June.

STREET TRADERS Street traders will not be allowed on or within 100 yards of The Route.

PORTABLE STANDS You are not allowed to take with you any form, box, chair, or other article which may be used as a portable stand.

LONDON TRANSPORT CORONATION EVE SERVICES

BUSES TROLLEYBUSES AND GREEN LINE COACHES as usual, but routes crossing the Coronation Area will be curtailed or diverted after midnight. Later journeys will be operated on some services. Green Line services will cease at normal times.

ALL-NIGHT BUSES curtailed or diverted (see Large Map) but **all-night trolleybuses** normal, with frequency of both all-night buses and trolleybuses improved to four vehicles an hour.

LONDON TRANSPORT TRAINS home until about 1.30 a.m. from the Central Area, except to stations beyond Rickmansworth and from Moorgate to Finsbury Park.

LONDON TRANSPORT CORONATION DAY SERVICES

London Transport road vehicles will display labels coloured in accordance with the colours of the Coronation Terminals they serve—choose your vantage point, then follow its colour.

BUSES TROLLEYBUSES AND GREEN LINE COACHES First buses arrive at Coronation Terminals about 4.30 a.m. First Green

Line coaches arrive at Coronation Terminals about 6 a.m. First trolleybuses arrive in the Central Area about 4.30 a.m. There will be bus and trolleybus connections from the outer areas to link with the early train services from London Transport stations. Last buses home leave Coronation Terminals about 1.30 a.m. and last Green Line coaches about 12 midnight. Last trolleybuses home leave the Central Area about 1.30 a.m.

Details of first and last journeys on buses and trolleybuses (shown blue on the Large Map) going near the Coronation Area will be advertised.

ALL-NIGHT BUSES curtailed or diverted up to about midnight (see Large Map) but **all-night trolleybuses** normal, with frequency of both all-night buses and trolleybuses improved to four vehicles an hour.

LONDON TRANSPORT TRAINS start at 3 a.m. from most outer terminal stations stopping at most stations (see list) until full services start at 5 a.m. Special late trains home from the Central Area until about 1.30 a.m. throughout Coronation Week except to stations beyond Rickmansworth and from Moorgate to Finsbury Park.

BY CAR OR TAXI

BEFORE AND AFTER CORONATION DAY

The West End of London will be very congested with traffic, and motorists will be acting in everybody's interests if they avoid going there. If the congestion becomes serious, the Police may have to close certain streets or areas entirely to vehicular traffic.

All vehicles within the Coronation Area on Coronation Eve (other than vehicles garaged off the highway) must be removed before midnight by the driver or other person in charge. If this is not done, the vehicle will be removed by the Police.

BY CAR OR TAXI CORONATION DAY

Cars will NOT be allowed inside the Coronation Area without an authorised windscreen label, and then only after 2.30 a.m. on Coronation Day. No vehicular traffic will be allowed on The Route.

ABBEY GUESTS Guests for Westminster Abbey must use the special routes shown in striped yellow on the Large Map; they may join these at any convenient point.

WINDSCREEN LABELS AND ROUTES Spectators travelling by private car must write to New Scotland Yard for a windscreen label of the colour of the section of The Route they wish to reach. Only written applications will be considered. Mark your envelope "Windscreen Labels", enclose a stamped addressed envelope measuring at least 7½" by 5", and state to which side of the road you wish to go, e.g. Regent St., east side; Piccadilly, north side. Fix the label in a conspicuous position on your windscreen, study the Large Map, and follow the roads indicated in the panel of your colour below it. All these roads may be reached by the Ring Road outlined in black on the Large Map. You will then be

directed into the Coronation Area by special routes signposted according to the same colour scheme by the Royal Automobile Club and the Automobile Association. The windscreen label does NOT guarantee entry into the Coronation Area for your car. It merely indicates to the Police which part of the Area you are anxious to reach, and they will help you as much as they can.

SETTING DOWN Cars can set down passengers either at the special car parks or as directed by the Police. If passengers are set down at places other than car parks, cars must be driven away immediately afterwards.

PARKING Parking will be permitted in certain signposted streets only. If the available parking space is full, drivers must leave the Coronation Area by the signposted routes immediately after setting down.

TAXIS Hired taxis will be permitted to enter the Coronation Area after midnight on Coronation Eve as far as is practicable. After passengers have been set down, taxis must leave the Coronation Area immediately. After 12 noon on Coronation Day, special taxi ranks will be formed at or near the Coronation Terminals. Taxis hired from these ranks must go directly outwards to the nearest point on the Ring Road.

IN THE EVENING access to the Central Area generally will be severely restricted on account of the floodlighting and firework display.

N.B. All the information in this folder covering the regulation of traffic on the streets is issued under the authority of the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis.

STATIONS CLOSED ALL DAY

BRITISH RAILWAYS

ON CORONATION DAY, the London suburban services of British Railways will start up specially early in the morning. On most lines there will be a service from about 3 a.m., followed by more frequent services later on. For details of these services, you should enquire at your local station.

FOR VISITORS FROM SCOTLAND and the provinces, travel by railway provides a trouble-free journey. The Main Line stations in London are linked with London Transport services which enable the Coronation Area to be easily reached.

BRITISH RAILWAYS will run additional early morning services to London and enquiries should be made at your local station, office, or agency, for full details of services and reduced fare arrangements.

ON CORONATION DAY, there will be a wide range of day return tickets, and, if you live over 150 miles from London, such tickets will be available from many places for use on British Railways trains after 9 p.m. on Coronation Eve.

EXCURSIONS WILL BE RUN from many areas in connection with Coronation Day, also during the festivities, illuminations and decorations throughout the Coronation period.

PRIVATE MOTOR COACHES

ON CORONATION DAY, coaches on regular services to Victoria Coach Station will be permitted to enter the Coronation Area; from that point, passengers should follow the Large Map to find their positions on The Route. Other coaches will set down and park at places outside the Coronation Area from which passengers can proceed by ordinary public transport. Further details as to the places near the Coronation Area to which coach passengers will be taken obtainable from coach operators or from the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis (Coronation Traffic Dept.), New Scotland Yard, S.W.1.

AIR PASSENGERS

K.L.M. to K.L.M. airways terminal in Sloane St. Passengers for B.E.A., AER LINGUS and all Continental Airlines other than K.L.M. will be transported to and from White City Stadium as an alternative to Waterloo Air Terminal between 11 p.m. June 1 and 7 a.m. June 3. From these points, passengers should use public transport or find their own way from the Large Map.

RIVER SERVICES

There will be frequent river services from Westminster and Charing Cross piers (as far as Putney upstream and Greenwich downstream) by which spectators may leave the Coronation Area after the Procession.

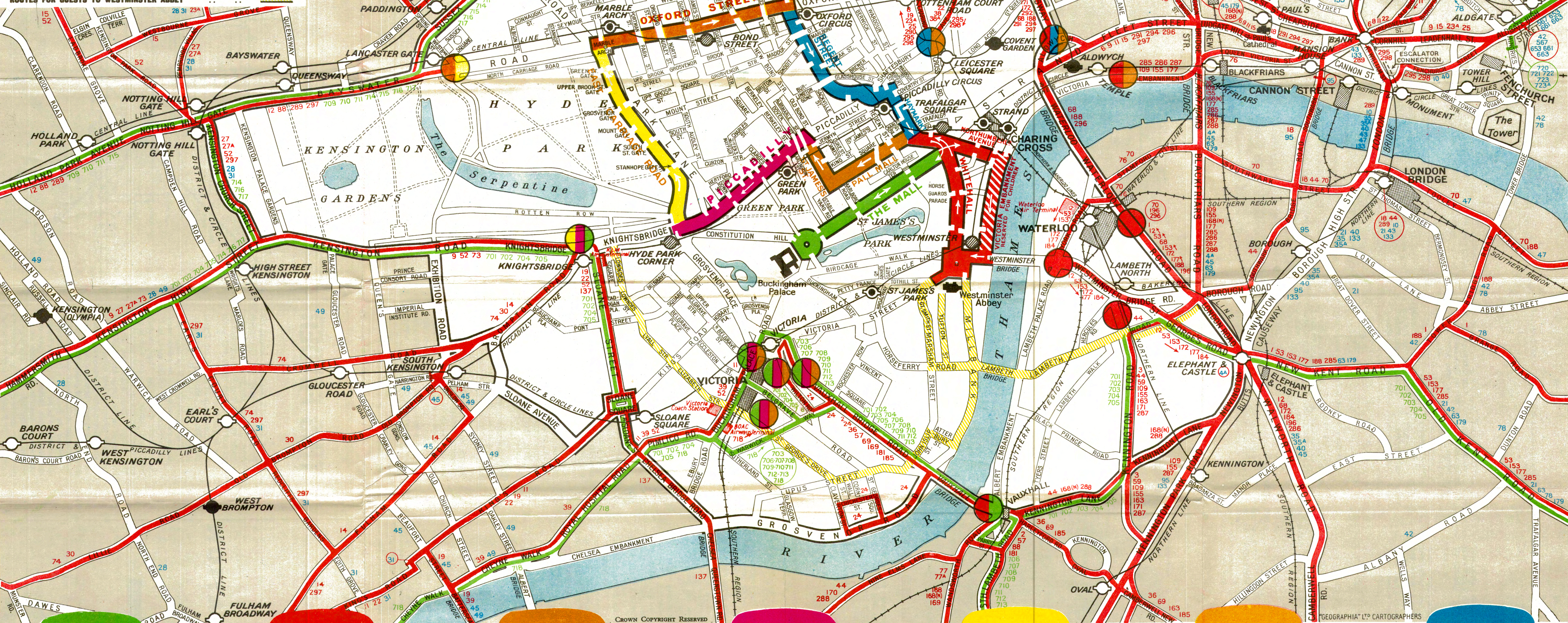
