

PROCEDURE TO PROTECT A STALLED TRAIN

1. GO BACK A SUFFICIENT DISTANCE FROM THE STALLED TRAIN SO THAT APPROACHING TRAIN CAN BE STOPPED BEFORE A COLLISION CAN OCCUR
2. FLAG APPROACHING TRAIN TO STOP



SWING HORIZONTALLY AT RIGHT
ANGLE TO TRACK

3. IF YOU WANT STOPPED TRAIN TO
MOVE UP



RAISE AND LOWER VERTICALLY

4. TO SLOW DOWN TRAINS ON ANOTHER
TRACK



HOLD HORIZONTALLY AT ARM'S
LENGTH

Note: Use hand or flag by day;
white lantern or flashlight
by night or in subway
